

**Annual Notice of Asbestos Management Plan 2014  
Académie Lafayette Oak St Campus, Kansas City**

Dear Parents, Guardians, Teachers, and Staff:

In accordance with the AHERA regulations of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), we are required to notify parents, guardians, teachers, and other employees each year of the availability of our Asbestos Management Plan and the response actions we are taking to maintain asbestos-containing materials in our school. While nearly all asbestos containing materials have been removed from the premises, there remain some in isolated or concealed locations.

The original AHURA inspection and subsequent re-inspections and response actions were performed the Kansas City, Missouri, Public school District prior to our ownership of the building. Since Académie Lafayette took occupation of the building, appropriate actions have continued to ensure that the remaining asbestos is maintained in good condition. All identified asbestos-containing materials in the school are well maintained in a non-friable condition.

Periodic surveillance of the remaining asbestos-containing materials in the building occurs on a regular basis. On May 21, 2013 a tri-annual inspection was performed by Apex Environmental, in accordance with AHERA regulations. On November 29, 2013, and May 19, 2014, I performed walk through inspections of the campus. There were no changes noted to asbestos containing materials in any location. Copies of these reports are on file in the main office of the school. Custodians and maintenance workers have also been instructed on the health effects of asbestos and the importance of maintaining the material in good condition during their normal day-to-day activities.
